Page 1: MEDICAL FORMS

All the required **Medical Forms** are located on the Companion App.

- **Doctors' Standing Order:** (Located on the App under doctor forms, needs to be signed by BOTH you and your child's pediatrician.)
- **Medication Form:** (Located on the App under doctor forms, needs to be signed by BOTH you and your child's pediatrician.) All prescription and over-the-counter medications **must** be listed on the Medication form. It is required by the New York State Department of Health for us to obtain this order to dispense any medications. We cannot dispense ANY medications without this form!!
- **Physical Exam and Immunization Records:** (You can get this from your child's pediatrician and must be within 2 years).

All the above forms are to be uploaded to the Doctor Forms

- **Meningitis Form:** (Located on the App under meningitis 2026, and needs to be signed by the Parent). Please upload to Meningitis
- **Parent Authorization Form:** (Located on the App under Parent Authorization 2026, needs to be signed by the parent. A copy of the front and back of your insurance card needs to be added.) Please, upload to Parent Authorization

Page 2: CAMP FORMS

All the required [Camp Forms](#) are located on the Companion App

- [Bunk Request](#): To be filled out by parents with the camper right on the Companion App. (Please note we can only accept 2 requests, and they need to be the same age, gender, and grade.) If your camper is new to Long Lake, be assured, we have many new campers in each session within your camper's age group. We have a combination of both new and returning campers in each bunk to ensure that both our new and returning campers are comfortable and feel welcomed.
- [Additional Options](#): To be filled out by the parents right on the Companion app. This section included Linen Rentals, Instrument rentals, and Horseback riding lessons
- [Camp Activities you Want](#): To be filled out by parents with the camper right on the App. Please list all the activities that your child is excited to try at camp, as well as any activities that you, the parents, would like to see your camper doing at camp.
- [Health History](#): To be filled out by the parents right on the App. This will help us take great care of your camper. All dietary needs, past or current medical conditions, and social-emotional needs will be added here. All current medications will be added here as well.
- [Transportation](#): To be filled out by the parents right on the App. This is where all the bus options, if chosen, would be, as well as the arriving by car option.

Page 3: Travel Options To Camp

- **Driving To Camp:**

- **The GPS Address / 83 Long Lake Camp Way Long Lake, NY 12847**

Please arrive between 2 and 4 pm. Our gates will NOT open before 2 pm, so please plan your driving times accordingly, as we are not able to accommodate campers arriving before 2 pm!

When you arrive at camp, you will be directed by our staff as to where to go. When advised to place your car in park, please exit your vehicle, and our staff will help you unload the luggage. PLEASE hand over ALL medications to the staff at this time so they can be brought to our infirmary to be checked in. No medications can be kept in your camper's luggage. Once your car is unloaded, you will be asked to get back into your vehicle and depart from camp.

ANYONE USING OUR BUS SERVICE, PLEASE SHIP AS MUCH LUGGAGE AS POSSIBLE TO US BEFORE CAMP. CAMPERS CAN BRING ONE DUFFEL BAG TO THE CHARTED BUSES. ALL SHIPPING DIRECTIONS CAN BE FOUND UNDER THE "SHIPPING LUGGAGE SECTION" OF THIS GUIDEBOOK.

- **Flying to Camp / Albany Airport Bus:**

(There is a \$100 charge for this service, \$200 for a round trip)

All flights need to be scheduled to land at Albany Airport between **11:30 am and 3 pm**. Any campers who are flying as an Unaccompanied minor should **CALL US** before booking so we can provide you with the needed details of our pick-up personnel. Any parents who meet us at Albany airport should meet us in baggage claim between 11:30 am and 3 pm. We send our most trusted staff to the airport, and we are easy to find due to our brightly colored T-shirts. Our staff will have all the flight details, names of campers flying or meeting us at baggage claim, and will be in constant contact with the main office. If any flight changes occur, you **must** give us a call as soon as you are aware of any flight delays or changes. Please also remind your camper that any medications they

bringing to camp MUST be turned in as soon as they arrive at camp. The bus usually arrives at camp between 5 and 6 pm.

-Arriving to Camp Bus Options

(There is a \$100 charge for this service) All campers who take the bus will need to pack a bagged lunch. Our buses do have AC and bathrooms on them, as well as our most trusted, experienced staff.

WEST ORANGE, NJ / Please arrive there by 7:30 am, Bus departs 8 am.

(This is the location of the Vanderhoof Bus Company we use.)

QUEENS, NY / Please be there by 9:30 am, bus departs 10 am

GPS: 9605 Queens Blvd., Rego Park, NY 11374

(The bus will pull up to the sidewalk on Junction Blvd., where there is space available.)

ARDSLEY, NY / Please be there by 10:30 am, bus departs between 11 and 11:30 am

GPS: Ardsley Travel Plaza locate on the NYS Thruway (I-87) between Exit 6A and Exit 7

CLIFTON PARK, NY / Please be there by 1:30 pm, bus departs approximately 2 pm

Page 5: Travel Options Home From Camp

Parent Pick up by car: Pick-up is between 9:30 and 11 am.

The campers will be at the top field with any luggage not picked up during parents' weekend. Please triple-check that they have all their belongings. We are not responsible for any items left at camp!

Bus To Albany Airport:

(There is a \$100 service fee for this option \$200 for a round-trip)

Again, all flights will need to be scheduled between 11:30 am and 3 pm. Our bus will depart from camp at 7:30 am on departure day and arrive at Albany Airport by 10 am. Any parents who are meeting us at baggage claim to pick up their camper should plan to arrive between 11:30 am and 3 pm.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Before the first performance, the owners will welcome everyone, introduce the Camp Directors and Unit leaders, and make important announcements – please don't miss it

HOTEL RESERVATIONS: Please find the list of hotels/motels attached. We suggest booking a hotel for both Friday and Saturday, and booking early as they fill quickly

PICK UP OF CAMPER BY OTHER THAN PARENT/GUARDIAN: If someone other than a parent/guardian will pick up your camper, we must have written permission from you as well as a copy of their driver's license

SWIMMING FOR PARENTS: Weather permitting, there may be times you are welcome to swim in our swimming area. Times will be on the Visitors' Weekend Schedule. Please note that there is NO SWIMMING allowed if our lifeguards are not on duty

LUGGAGE PICKUP: While you're at camp on Friday and Saturday, please plan on looking for your camper's luggage at the Tennis Courts, which is close to the parking area. Please load that into your car.

TRIPLE CHECK YOU HAVE EVERYTHING: Many items are left behind each session. Please look through your campers' luggage and items you've gathered to be certain you have everything. Ask your camper if they are missing anything (medications, artwork, etc.). We are not responsible for forgotten items

CAN'T JOIN US: If you're not able to join us for the weekend, please know we will look after your camper. We also record performances and send out links in the fall.

Page 9: Shipping Luggage:

All families using our bus services, we ask that you ship as much luggage as possible to the camp. We can only allow 1 duffel bag on the chartered bus per camper. (Not including a personal item i.e., backpack)

Please send via UPS or FedEx. We suggest UPS as they offer to pick up from your house, 1-800-PICK-UPS. We do not accept trunks or hard luggage. Please use soft luggage only; duffel bags are ideal. Soft luggage with wheels is also fine. Campers will unpack into cubbies/drawers/hanging spaces, and their duffels will be placed under their beds. We recommend shipping the luggage 4-7 days before the start of the camp. If you would like us to ship the luggage back home, you will need to provide us with a return UPS label.
